Number 7 is the best known Humoreque from the series of 8. The arrangement has been transposed to G (original is in G-flat, which seems to be much more difficult to play than G) and written in 4/4 instead of 2/4 (4/8) to make it more readable. The first voice assumes the presence of high notes (up to B).

Besides the arrangement for 5 accordions there is also an arrangement for duo. By combining parts from both you can also do 3 or 4 accordions.

Professor P made a recording available to illustrate what the arrangement may sound like.






